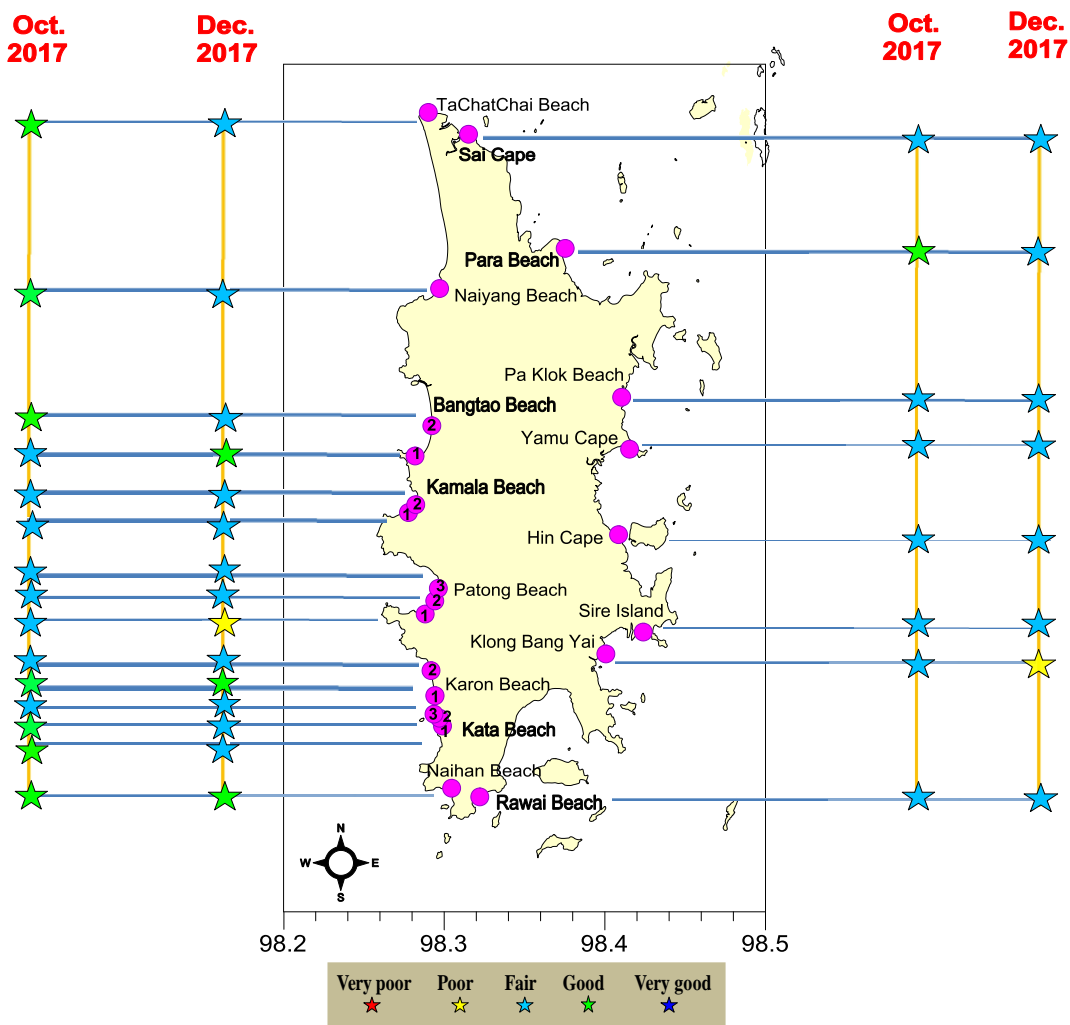


Marine water quality along the coastline of Phuket in 2018

Phuket Marine Biological Center has implemented a coastal environment monitoring program for 23 stations along the coastline of Phuket. Some principal parameters collected every 2 months include salinity, temperature, pH, dissolved oxygen, suspended sediment, nutrients, and total coliform bacteria. These parameters were analyzed and interpreted in term of marine water quality indices.



Marine water quality during October–December 2017 was generally found in fair condition, except Patong Beach and Klong Bang Yai have poor condition during December 2017. Typical parameters causing downgraded water quality were increasing in nutrient concentrations, especially Phosphate, and total coliform bacteria.
